

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Life-wide Learning Fund

To encourage students to participate in Life-wide learning (LWL) activities, the school is going to apply for the Hong Kong Jockey Club Life-wide Learning Fund to subsidize financially needy students. Details are as follows:

Aim of the fund	The Fund aims to support financially needy students to participate in LWL programmes.
Targets	Hong Kong's Primary 1 to Secondary 6 students: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance; OR 2. receiving a full grant under the School Textbook Assistance Scheme (full grant); OR 3. meeting the school's established "financially needy" criteria
Funding Scope	Fees (transportation and additional fees included) for joining local or non-local LWL activities organised or recognised by the school, for example study visits, study camp, activities related to uniform groups/ music/ physical education, leadership training, etc.
Subsidy Amount	Dependent on the number of applications and nature of activities. Please refer to the respective notices of activity.
How to apply	Students should submit the following supporting documents when joining LWL activities: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) recipients: supporting evidence of receiving CSSA, e.g. certificate of CSSA recipients (for Medical Waivers) issued by the Social Welfare Department 2. School Textbook Assistance Scheme (full-grant) recipients: no documents required (the school will refer to the data provided by the Student Finance Office of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency for identification) 3. Other financially needy students (e.g. referral case, single-parent family, new arrivals, etc.): written application and supporting documents
Remarks	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Information provided will only be used for fund application. 2. Advance payment is required in joining LWL activities. Full refund will be arranged for applicants with satisfactory performance. 3. Subsidized students must complete the related assignments and might be required to join the sharing sessions. 4.
