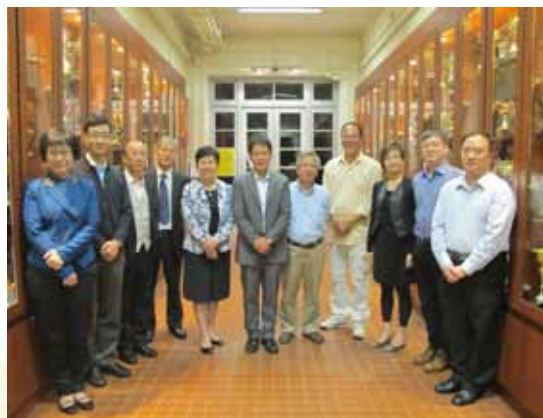


School Management Committee (SMC)

Achievements on Major Concerns

The School is committed to providing quality learning and teaching through the implementation of the two major concerns. To achieve the goals set, on-going evaluation was conducted and strategies were refined in these years. We are pleased to have met all the success criteria and attained the targets to the best of our efforts.





Major Concern 1: To further develop the school as a learning community

In the domain of quality teaching and assessment for learning, with all the subjects, except Physical Education, the teaching of Higher Order Thinking skills was incorporated in their respective curricula. We have drawn up a school-based subject-based HOT skills teaching curriculum for all levels. Students are proficient enough to apply the HOT skills learnt and have achieved very impressive results.

To enhance reading competence and cultivate a good reading habit, thematic reading materials were prepared by subject departments and committees for the morning reading session on Wednesdays. Students are exposed to texts of different genres and on different topics, hence widening their reading experiences and knowledge. Students are given plenty of opportunities to share and discuss what they have read during Cross-curricular Activity Periods and Campus TV broadcast.

Teachers have designed and implemented progressive curricula in the two language subjects to enhance students' confidence and strengthen their speaking and presentation skills. Interactive learning activities, like drama and debate, are built in the language curricula. The daily King's Morning serves as a good training ground for Masters of Ceremony for school functions while the year-end Knowledge Fair, apart from showcasing students' achievements and learning experiences through the activities they have joined, provides a platform for the demonstration of the skills students have acquired.

A lot more resources have been invested in the domain of IT in learning and teaching. The IT committee provides invaluable support to teachers by organizing workshops and sharing sessions throughout the school year. Subjects like Liberal Studies and ICT continue to make use of online learning forums to facilitate cooperative learning. Many other subjects provide online assignments for pre-lesson preparation, or use other e-learning resources for self-directed learning or project learning.

As a learning community, our teachers have actively engaged in various modes of professional development activities. They conducted self-reflection and peer evaluation in sessions of Peer lesson Observation, Pedagogy Studies and Open Class. Teachers are ready to share their learning experiences on different occasions like staff or departmental meetings. They attended professional training seminars or workshops of different kinds to further enhance their capabilities. The learning enthusiasm of teachers has contributed to the strengthening of the learning community in our school.



Major Concern 2: To strengthen students' life-long learning skills and culture

Adopting a whole-school approach, the School has arranged an extensive range of activities and programmes to foster students' personal, affective, social, aesthetic and cultural development and hone their life-long learning skills.

A school-based Life Planning and Career Guidance Service framework was designed by the Careers and Life Education Committee aiming to empower students of different ages, attributes and abilities with the necessary life skills for future studies and career. The Committee works in close collaboration with various local universities and our alumni for the provision and conduct of programmes and guidance service to students and parents on multiple pathways.

In our long history, the School has never stopped to nurture future leaders. Students were given opportunities to participate in different leadership training programmes both in and outside school. Students have their leadership abilities enhanced by taking up responsible positions in the Student Union, the six houses and the 35 Extracurricular Activities Clubs and Societies. The School Magazine and Newspaper Editorial Board, Campus Reporters, Campus TV Team, School Ambassadors, just to name some, have done all their best proving their leadership and skill competence in their own domains which the school takes pride in. They also played an active part in different inter-school student organizations like the Union of the Young Leaders.

The launch of the Student Development Day since 2012 has certainly helped students to learn beyond classroom through their participation in field trips, leadership training camps, subject-related form-based study tours, visits to different organizations and tertiary institutes, services at voluntary organizations, career talks, etc. By providing such an educational experience to our students, they have been fostered as individuals, as part of a team and as responsible members of society.





Learning is also extended beyond the confines of Hong Kong. Students are given the chance to engage in experiential learning and cultural changes through their participation in different theme-based educational study tours. The two-day one-night tour to Guangzhou for all S.2 students facilitated a comparative study on the economic development and people's livelihood between Hong Kong and the mainland while the tour to Guizhou allowed students to teach a group of primary school students at an impoverished village. These years, our students have their footprints marked all over the globe stretching from the Mainland, Taiwan, Macau, Singapore, Japan to United Kingdom, New Zealand, etc. It is encouraging to note that the tours have received overwhelmingly positive support from both parents and students.

We are determined to nurture students to become caring citizens who are ready to serve and to give. Besides serving as voluntary teaching assistants at King's College-YWCA Elder Academy, students through their involvement in the Interact Club, the Community Youth Club, the Junior Police Call, the Voluntary Service Team, the Social Service Group and the three uniform groups, they have learned to appreciate the essence of giving and become more committed to taking on social responsibilities.

Students are given plenty of opportunities to share life experience with old boys and girls on different occasions. With the continuous support from the King's College Old Boys' Association, our students benefit greatly from the Mentorship Scheme, the Job Shadowing Programme and the High Table Dinner.

Kingsians achieved good results in the 2015 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination.

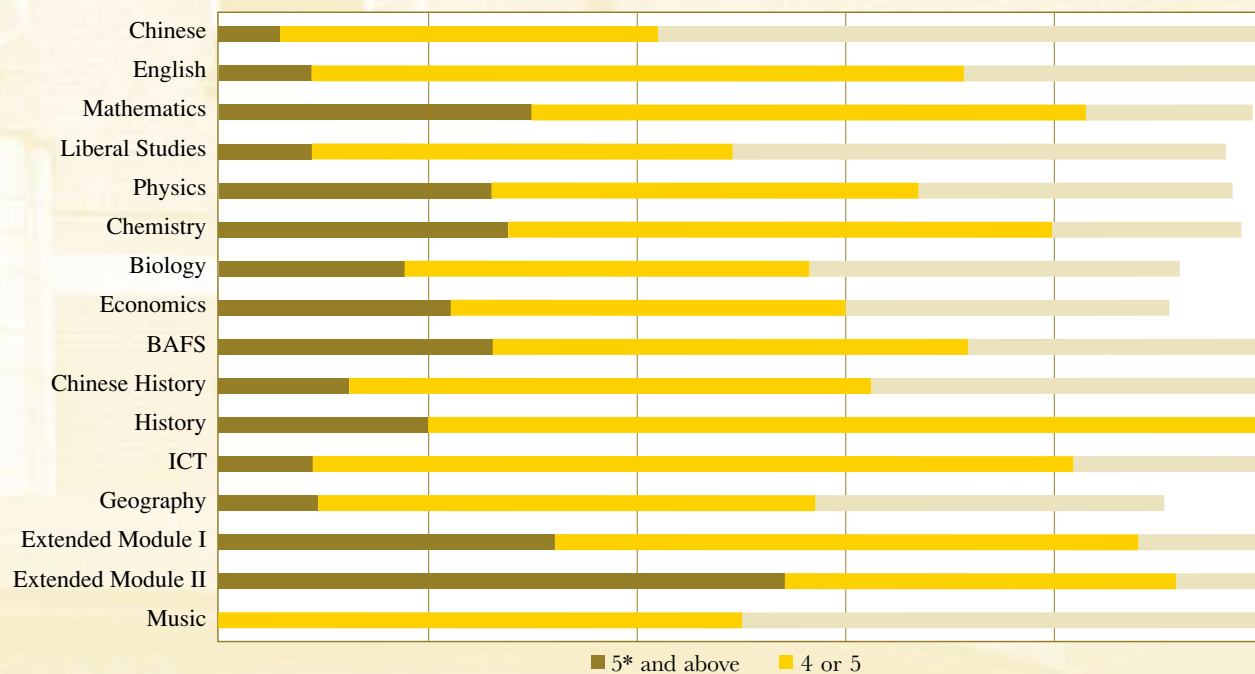

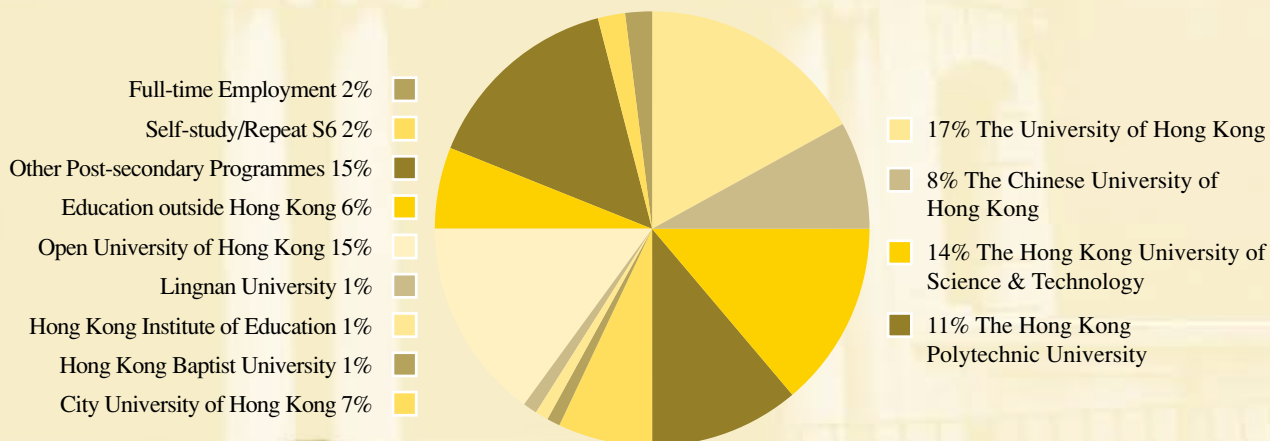

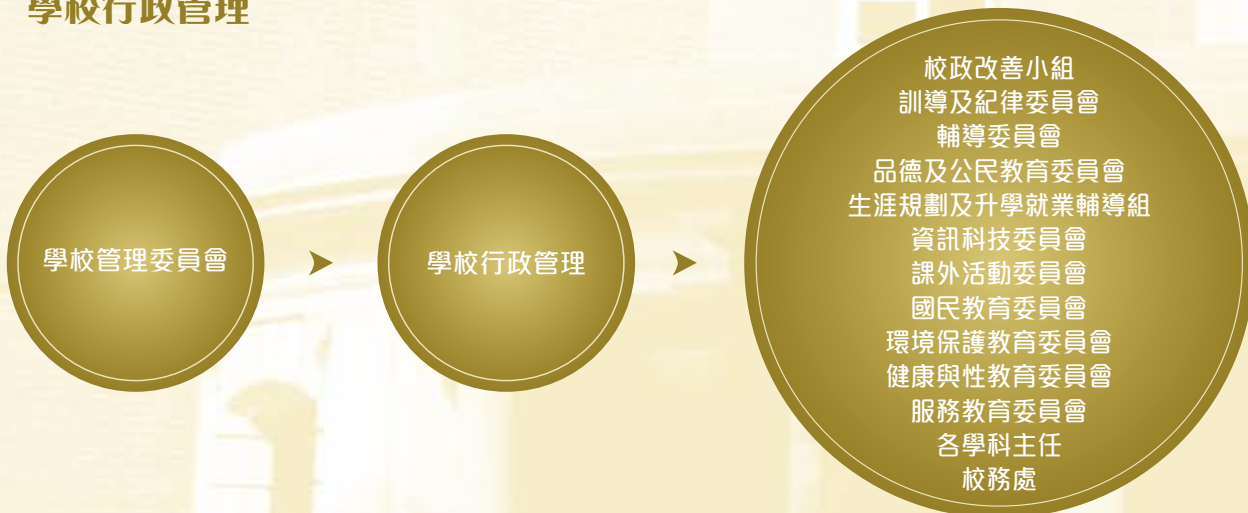
本校使命

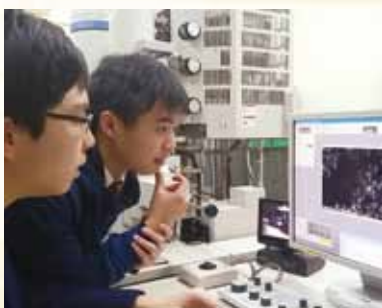
本校除校長、兩位副校長及五十五位教師外，還有一位圖書館館長、六名教學助理、四位實驗室技術員及一位駐校社工。

本學年的關注事項有以下兩個範疇：

- 發展學生潛能，拓闊學習經歷

關注事項成效

本校於本年度的教學主題為「關顧與欣賞」，透過兩大「關注事項」，致力提供優質的學與教活動，優化學習社群，提升終身學習能力，精益求精，追求卓越。

關注事項一：優化學校成為學習型社群

首先，本校於各科推行「高階思維技巧課程」，並締造不同的學習經歷，強化學生的說話能力，並提升協作能力。另一方面，本校亦積極以協作教學和開放課，促進了老師之間的專業交流，提升教學質素。

此外，本校致力提升學生的閱讀能力，透過廣泛閱讀，開拓學生視野。在「主題閱讀課」，同學閱讀不同主題的讀物，擴展閱讀經驗，亦從「跨學科活動課」的閱讀分享環節，由閱讀大使帶領同學反思，提升理解及賞析技巧，增強品德情意。另一方面，本校舉辦校園電視及閱讀論壇，由老師及閱讀大使分享心得，提高閱讀興趣，有效營造校園的閱讀文化。

本校亦善用資訊科技，與時並進。為了在課堂提高師生的互動性，老師在籌劃學習活動，運用平板電腦，發展學生創意，提高學習興趣。另一方面，學生亦樂於利用網上學習平台，運用電子資源自主學習，提升教與學的效能。

關注事項二：提升學生終身學習的能力及文化

首先，本校採取全校參與模式，安排多元化的活動，貫徹全人發展的教學理念，培養學生的德智體群美，為未來作好準備。由生涯規劃及升學就業輔導組，以全面的升學就業輔導服務框架，幫助學生發展全面的人生規劃，並提供就業指導服務，協助他們確立就業目標，使現行的「升學就業教育計劃」更加完善。

此外，本校積極培育學生的領導才能。同學擔任不同學會、活動的要職，在老師的指導下，帶領幹事，共同推行全年的活動，並鼓勵學生在早會或其他學校活動內分享，促進反思和回饋。另外，自



2012年起，本校舉辦學生發展日，提升多元課外學習經歷，他們透過實地考察、領袖培訓營、職業講座、參觀及社區服務等活動，擴闊視野，提升抗逆力和解難能力，並提高對社區的歸屬感。

除此之外，本校亦組織課外學習活動，培養團隊精神，增加相關的學習機會。除了聯課學習活動、講座、表演，以及校內、校際和國際性比賽外，更籌備交流團，如通識教育科，特意為中二級學生舉辦廣州遊學團，讓學生了解中國與香港在經濟上的合作關係，提升國民身分的理解和認同。近年，得到老師及家長的大力支持，學生的足跡更遍佈國內、澳門、台灣、新加坡、日本、英國、新西蘭等地，讓學生發展國際視野。

最後，學生在長者學苑、少年警訊、公益少年團及其他制服團體中，服務社群，體會「施比受更為有福」的道理，並提升公民意識。此外，有賴校友的支持，同學在師友計劃、職場影子計劃、高桌晚宴等活動中，獲益良多，體現薪火相傳的英皇精神。

學校活動

本校活動主要有水運會、陸運會、越野賽、音樂比賽、開放日、遊戲日、畢業禮、家長日及教師專業發展日等。

提升及豐富學生的「其他學習經歷」
