### Annual Athletics Meets (Heat & Final)

Blessed by the warm and sunny weather, the Annual Athletics Meets were successfully held at the Wanchai Sports Ground on 19 & 24 March 2014. Dr. NG Yin-ming, Consultant of the Department of Paediatrics of the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, was invited to officiate the Prize Presentation Ceremony. #### Hong Kong Youth Science & Technology Innovation Competition 2013 - 2014

A team of S.5 students of our school investigated the effectiveness of utilization of chlorophyll in harvesting the solar energy and converting them into electricity. They invented a chlorophyll solar cell with efficiency up to 1.0 %. With this remarkable invention, they won three prizes which were the First Place Grand Award in the category of "Energy and Environmental Science", the Best Project Award and Ricoh Sustainable Development Award 2014. In recognition of the team leader, Chu Yat Ho's outstanding performance, he was also awarded the Youth Scientist Award.

Another team of S.4 and S.5 students investigated the possibility of implanting a blood glucose empowered lifelong pacemaker. They invented a sustainable glucose fuel cell with power stabilizing system which could be potentially implanted in human body. They were awarded the Second Place Grand Award in the category of "Chemistry and Materials" for this impressive scientific research result. For more...
