With the outstanding project named "Dye-sensitized Chlorophyll Solar Cells Using Crude Chlorophyll Extract Coupled with Natural Cysteine-assisted Ag/Ppy Ion Carriers and Water Electrolyte", our students were awarded the Third Award in the Category of Chemistry.
