Our students had excellent performance in renowned competitions

- The 33rd China Adolescents Science and Technology Innovation Contest (第三十三屆全國青少年科技創新大賽) was successfully held in August 2018 in Chongqing. A student from our school Research Team was selected to represent Hong Kong to compete in this contest. Congratulations were extended to CHAU Chiu-wang (5D) who attained the Second Class Award (二等獎). He investigated the possibility of employing superparamagnetic Fe₃O₄ NPs in treating contaminated water.
- Nineteen of our S.2 to S.4 students participated in the Global Round of the World Scholar's Cup 2018 from 16 August to 21 August 2018 in Melbourne, Australia. Despite the intense competition, our World Scholar's Cup team rose to the occasion and snapped 53 gold medals and 61 silver medals and all the teams are qualified for the Tournament of Champions to be held at Yale University in November.
- The Inter-school Swimming Competition 2018-2019 Division Three (Hong Kong Island) heat and final rounds were held on 4 and 12 October respectively at Victoria Park Swimming Pool. Our Swimming Team performed outstandingly well, coming third in Boys A Grade 4 x 50m Medley Relay. LAM Yuk-wang of 1D was the Champion in Boys C Grade 50m Freestyle while LIN Pak-him Phidias of 6C and LEUNG Ching-long of 5A came third in Boys A Grade 50m Backstroke and 200m Freestyle respectively.
