Our students got excellent results in all arenas:

- The Hong Kong Chemistry Olympiad for Secondary School 2018-2019 Four of our 5.4 and 5.5 students from the Chemistry Research Team won the 1st Runner up in the Hong Kong Chemistry Olympiad for Secondary School 2018-2019 with their project titled, "Dye-Sensitized TiO2-Catalysed Photodecomposition of Methanal".
- The 21st Hong Kong Youth Science and Technology Innovation Competition This competition is the largest and most popular science competition in Hong Kong with about 4,000 participants from over 400 schools. The prize presentation ceremony was held at the Hong Kong Science Park on 31 March 2019 and officiated by the Permanent Secretary for Education, Mrs. YEUNG HO Poi-yan, Ingrid, JP. Our students, WONG Sonny (2D) and LAU Kit-fai (1C), attained the 3rd Place Award in the Energy and Environmental Science category (Junior Secondary Division) with their research project on anti-formaldehyde.
